The new building that will be the future home of New Hope Resource Center on the campus of Colbert Presbyterian Church is quickly nearing completion. According to project manager David Sullivan from Copeland Architects, the construction will be completed and the greatly expanded space will be ready for occupancy by early March.

New Hope will continue to offer the services it currently provides but the enhanced space will allow room for a clothing bank and the potential for additional educational and informational opportunities. It will also have improved handicap access to these services.

Words cannot adequately express the gratitude we feel for the generous outpouring of support for this project in terms of financial contributions and pledges from members of Colbert Presbyterian Church and the New Hope Board of Directors. 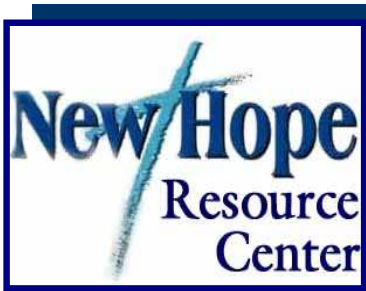
As we are nearing completion of this project there are still some items that are needed to complete the transition to our new space. Please prayerfully consider making a contribution of these items or a monetary donation towards their purchase:

- Electric drop in range (30" wide with matching 30" hood)
- Refrigerator (maximum 36" wide and 70" high)
- Washer and dryer (standard 30" or newer 27") for use in the clothing bank
- Dishwasher (34")
- Desktop copier
- Paper shredder
- Door chimes (2 at least)
- 6 networked phones or that are compatible
- Art work (décor colors are yellow and sage green)
- Door mats
- Kids rug for kids area in reception room
- Ice tea maker
- Microwave oven
- Kitchen supplies to include cookie sheets and pot holders
